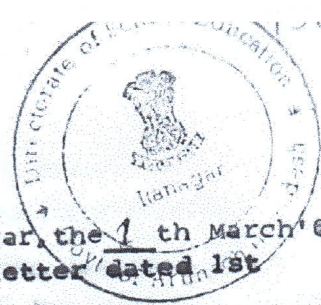

With reference to your letter dated 1st

March'2006, formal recognition / upgradation from Primary to Middle level is granted to St. Joseph's School, Seppa, District, East Kameng Arunachal Pradesh run and managed by Kameng Social Service Society, Seppa for running classes upto Middle standard w.e.f. 4th February' 2006, the date of approval from the competent authority.

The recognition is granted on the following terms and conditions :-

1. The guidelines in respect of recognition of school conveyed through order No. EDA.20/90-91 (Vol-II), dated 22nd January' 2004 shall have to be observed in letter and spirit. Further, the recognition of the school does not carry any financial commitment from the Govt. side.

In addition, the following additional guidelines shall be strictly complied with :-

2. Arunachal Pradesh traditional culture must be preserved.
3. Syllabus prescribed by the Directorate of School Education, A.P. / CBSE, New Delhi for the school will have to be followed.
4. No religious activity should be under taken either directly or indirectly in the school / hostel campus.
5. There should be emphasis on the quality education.
6. Norms of recognition applicable in respect of other institution shall also be applicable to the institution.
7. Direct or indirect violation noticed in respect of the above mentioned conditions may lead to deterrent action including closure of the school.
8. Govt. will not be bound to provide any land allotment in case of any such school.
9. The question of Govt. grant in appropriate cases will however be considered only if such schools meet all the stringent rules and regulations prescribed for other voluntary organization schools.
10. No church, temple, mosque or any other religious activity shall be carried out within the school campus.

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11. No preaching etc. in the guise of seminar, discourse talk by any religious body or patrons or preachers of any religious institution will be acceptable.
12. The Principal of the school and the Secretary of the governing body must report to the prescribed Govt. authority from time to time to indicate whether the above mentioned government institutions are being observed.
13. The Deputy Commissioner of the district or any representative authorised by him or DSE will be free to obtain necessary feedback from any such school by way of inspection / calling for report etc.
14. If in the view of Dy. Commissioner, there is any communal turn due to any reason related to such religious activity in the school or if any disaffection is caused among the students because of the same, then the Dy. Commissioner will have right to initiate appropriate action against the authorities of the school and he shall suitably inform the Govt. about the action taken and the Government may take suitable action.
